

### Corporate Enforcement Authority (CEA) Report on Protected Disclosures 2024

The Protected Disclosures Act 2014, as amended, requires public bodies to prepare and publish a report each year relating to the number of protected disclosures (internal and external) made to public bodies in the preceding year in addition to detailing the action taken in response to the disclosures made.

The CEA is prescribed by law to receive protected disclosures from workers in connection with all matters relating to the CEA's functions (as set out in section 944D of the Companies Act 2014). The CEA has in place both internal and external reporting channels and procedures.
